# Stakeholder Meeting Questions

#### General Questions

How often is the parking lot utilized?

- Every day, Sunday most, dop off for metro catholic and UCS for student. 1 bus, 15 +/- Students, parents. Afternoon. Wednesday Food pantry 120 people, 80% is car volume. The South half gets used more often. North gets used for mission house, but not as many cars. Hot meal program Tuesday and Thursday night, park mostly south lot. Weekend activity 2/3 full south. Funerals, weddings full, maybe additional +/- 3 times year for church picnic, St. Patrick's day dance. Wintertime cars will park in lot to get off streets. Dumpster/recycling can move if needed.
- Potential future renovations of building and concern for damage to new pavement
- Busses could potentially be kept on W.38<sup>th</sup> street. It is now 2 way.
- Snow gets placed in greenspace and in front of Mission house.

Are there certain days of the week it is used more than others?

How often is the parking lot full, with no open spaces?

Do you park cars in any nonstandard ways (not in designated parking spaces)?

• No, only on St. Patric's Day.

Is the parking lot ever used for special events (ie. Food trucks, tents, rides, etc.)?

Trunk or treat. Debated about putting parish picnic. Dreams of block party parish picnic.

How does the parking lot perform in terms of user functionality? Are there any thoughts or ideas on ways to improve this?

• Odd curve is not desired.

At one time the lot was a major throughfare cut through.

• Potentially cut Bridge Avenue entrance to w. 38<sup>th</sup>.

Are there any safety concerns with how the parking lot is used?

• Gets a lot of pedestrian traffic from street.

Are there any pedestrian circulation/connections that need to be enhanced?

• Path, station of the cross – Park like walkthrough would be nice.

#### Stormwater Questions
